

# PREVENTING COVID-19 SPREAD DURING CALF REARING

## PROTOCOLS TO APPLY DURING CALF REARING TO REDUCE COVID-19 RISK IN YOUR FARM OPERATION

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- 1** **Wear your own protective clothing** and disposable gloves (if available). Wash clothing in hot water and detergent at the end of day.



- 2** **Sanitise gloves** with 70% alcohol/other disinfectant between tasks and wash your hands regularly. Avoid touching your face

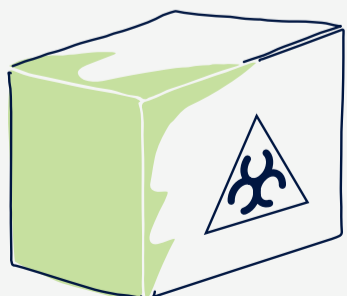


- 3** If **more than one person** is required in the calf shed, **stay over 1.5m apart**. Assign team members to work in specific areas of calf rearing facility



- 4** **Clean and disinfect equipment** after you've finished using it. Identify all personal equipment to avoid it being used by others

- 5** **Regularly clean and disinfect** surfaces commonly handled by multiple people e.g. gates



- 6** **Quarantine** (7 days) or **disinfect** all deliveries used in calf rearing
